Docuseries contending freedom of choice is a neoliberal illusion.

Seventh Age: Suicide

Vulnerable population presented with a choice to live a life too inconvenient or defamiliarizing to accommodate or die.

Sixth Age: Retirement

Sociocultural aversion to multigenerational households being what it is, assisted living is not chosen but required by the Baby Boom generation.

Fifth Age: Consumption

Necessary items for sale in a modern market economy like food, shelter, clothing, cell-phone/internet access are implicative, Sticky Loops.

Fourth Age: Deviance

The Non-Binary/Binary Binary summarizes how deviant points of view are oppositional to the norm they perpetuate. See Barbie, Wednesday, Oppenheimer.

Third Age: Consent

Because sexual and vocational freedom are constrained by socioecomic inequity, neither intimate nor labour-related relationships can be engaged in freely.

Second Age: School

Because schooling is required of children whose parents must work, the manner in which children are indoctrinated isn't optional.

First Age: Language

Language limits freedom, such that the popular lexicon, preoccupied with pronouns, won't recognize possession inherent in the pronouns are problematic—from the pan to the fire.
